



Overage Eligibility Criteria (07's in 2008 Major AAA Division)

For a 2007 to be eligible to play in the 2008 Major AAA Division in the 2020-21 Hockey Super League Season they must meet a MINIMUM of 2 of the following criteria. Please note that the eligibility will only be extended to athletes who played on 2008 Major teams in the 2019-20 season, NO new 2007 born athletes will be eligible for this division.

The criteria are as follows:

1. Athlete has a birthdate in the 2nd half of the year. (July to December)
2. Less than 1 Penalty Minute Per Game Average in previous HSL season.
3. Athlete must be within the 77th percentile of children born in 2008 on July 1st.

4. Goalie

Teams that are requesting an overage athlete in the 2008 division must submit the player's name, birthdate, height and weight prior to July 1st.

Eligibility for 09 Born Athletes in 2008 Major AAA Division

Please be advised that 2009 born athletes will NOT be eligible to play in the 2008 Major AAA division, despite the information that is listed in the 2020-21 HSL Application Package. This includes NO 2009 athletes being used as affiliate players in the 2008 Major AAA division.





Minimum Number of Goalies Per Roster

The HSL prefers that each team have a total of TWO goalies rostered for the season. However, it is the individual team's decision to carry either one or two goalies. If a team has decided that they only want to carry one goalie, it is up to the team to ensure that they have an affiliated goalie that will be available for the showcase in the case that their one goalie is unable to play. The HSL will not be assisting a team that carries one goalie in the case of an emergency, this is solely the responsibility of the individual team. If a team carrying one goalie is unable to have their goalie arrive on time, or is not on hand, they will be forced to dress a player, as the league will not allow games to be forfeited or delayed due to the team not having a second goalie. Affiliate goalies will be ONLY be able to be pulled up from a division below. (ie: 2009 Major team will ONLY be able to bring a goalie in from 2009 Minor or below).

In the case of an injury mid-game to a goalie who is the only one rostered on his team, the team must dress a player to complete the game.

2008 Major AAA Affiliation

2008 Major AAA affiliates will come from the 2008 Major AA or 2008 Minor division. Athletes must be born in 2008. The HSL will host a voluntary Checking Clinic for those athletes who would take the clinic for purposes of affiliation through the season. Teams will be provided with a list of athletes who have taken the clinic to allow them to know which athletes are eligible.

This clinic will not be for whole teams, but for individual athletes who will be affiliates.

The cost for the Checking Clinic will be \$225 + GST, registration information will be passed out as it becomes available.

2008 Major AAA teams that have 2008 Minor OR 2008 Major AA teams can ONLY affiliate from that team directly.

2008 Major AAA teams that DO NOT have 2008 Minor teams will be eligible to affiliate from any 2008 Minor team. However, the franchise that they are affiliating the player from MUST sign a letter allowing their athlete to affiliate with the 2008 Major AAA team.

2008 Major AAA teams can affiliate a MAX of (4) four 2008 Minor/2008 Major AA athletes for the season. They are eligible to play a maximum of (10) ten games as an AP during the season





Athletes will be eligible to affiliate with up to (2) two teams per season. Teams are recommended to have athletes affiliated from both the North and South regions, this allows teams to have the opportunity to call up an athlete in case of emergency while attending a road showcase.

Affiliate players must make their regular teams a priority, they are ineligible to affiliate if:

- Their regular team is playing in a showcase at the same time
- There is a team practice, unless the Head Coach signs off on the athlete being able to play for affiliate team
- Affiliate team has 12 or more skaters dressed

General Affiliation Rules

Affiliate Players (AP) are only permitted in the following cases:

1. A team has LESS than (12) twelve skaters available to be dressed for a game
2. A team has only one (1) or less healthy goalie

AP's must meet the following criteria:

1. From a division BELOW the level of the team affiliating the player (Athletes playing under-age in the division above ARE NOT eligible to affiliate in a division below them. I.e: 2010 playing 09 is NOT eligible to AP with a 2010 team)
2. Athletes are only permitted to be affiliated with TWO teams/FRANCHISES per season
3. Athletes are only permitted to play a maximum number of 10 games as an AP throughout the season
3. From the same franchise, this is the first option and must be pursued initially;
 - a. In the case that an athlete is not available from within their own franchise:
 - i. You may request an athlete from another franchise under the following stipulations:
 1. They are playing in a division below; athletes playing as under-age in divisions above will be ineligible (2009 born athletes are unable to AP into the 2008 Major AAA division)
 2. The franchise that they play for must sign off on allowing them to be an AP with another franchise
 3. The athlete's full-time team has no games, missing practice will be at the discretion of the team
 4. In the case of hitting divisions, the athlete being AP'd MUST have completed an HSL Contact Clinic





5. Athletes are permitted to Affiliate with up to TWO teams per season

****Please be reminded that the intent of allowing Affiliates is to be used in the case of emergency. It is never to displace current roster players. Teams found to be using athletes in place of their own rostered players, or using AP's and having a roster of OVER (12) skaters WILL LOSE THE RIGHT TO USE AP's.****

Affiliate Approval Process:

1. Date and time of the game
2. Number of healthy athletes that will be dressed
3. Reasons why other athletes are unable to play, including doctor's note (if applicable)
4. Athlete that will be Affiliated and a note signed off on by the other franchise (if AP is from another franchise)
5. Email all details directly to twowk@silentice.com
6. We will then review and approve or deny your application

All affiliates must be approved by the league. Upon approval, the athlete must be added to the team's online roster as an Affiliate Player. This will allow the player to properly be marked down on the game sheet.
